Partners IARS, IDEC, NOVEL GROUP, SUBVERSIVE FRONT, SYMPLEXIS and CAMINOS have finalised and published our accredited, free training program for teachers and parents that aims to:

- 1. Inform and empower teachers with gender sensitivity training.
- 2.Clarify notions of gender, raise awareness, and promote dialogue between school staff and parents.
- 3. Give teachers educational tools and methodology to identify, combat and report gender-based discrimination.

The training platform contains a handbook for parents and teachers as well as 5 training modules with interactive activities, videos and discussion tools.



PILOTING WITH TEACHERS AND PARENTS

Over the last two months, project partners of the FREE Project have been piloting our FREE from gender-based discrimination in schools training with teachers and parents in Greece, Spain, North Macedonia and the UK.

The piloting has been a great success with some amazing feedback and areas for improvement from teachers and parents.

The piloting took place in three stages. An initial meeting and explanation of the **platform** and how to sign up, time for teachers to go away and complete the training modules, and finally, a discussion with parents and teachers together to receive feedback and have a natural discussion of the platform and their experiences.

Finally we received some amazing evaluations from teachers and parents, directing us on how we can improve the platform, training and overall process, ready for teachers to use it to it fullest potential.
